2022 State MISS Resume Instructions

- Due Date: Upload to Website March 18, 2022
- Bring 10 PRINTED copies to Orientation March 26

This is your opportunity to demonstrate to the state judges why they should consider you for the job of Miss Minnesota. Your **RESUME**, combined with the **Social Impact Initiative Statement** will comprise your entire application for this job. The judges will receive exactly what is submitted.

Instructions for Candidate's Resume

- Resume can be one (1) page only
- Leave a one-half inch (1/2") margin on all sides of the resume
- Create in the style/format Candidate feels best reflects interviewing for the job of Miss Minnesota 2022
- Your Resume can be in Color
- You can use ONE photo on your resume. It does not have to be your official headshot.
- Print on white paper. You can use Presentation paper, but **No heavy card stock.**
- Use any style font – but nothing less than 10-point
- The following **MUST** be included on your resume:
Name – Social Impact Initiative– School attending or graduated – Talent – Date of Birth

State Instructions: Place 10 copies each of Resume & Social Impact Initiative in one envelope with metal clasp. Label with your name and title on the outside of envelope. Bring to Orientation to turn in.

Copies of both your Resume & Social Impact Statement must also be uploaded to the Miss Minnesota website resource portal @ missminnesota.org, no later than March 18, 2022.

The following are only suggestions and ideas for your resume.

Create a Resume that best reflects who you are, your accomplishments and qualifications to successfully fulfill the duties of the role of Miss Minnesota. The following ideas do not have to appear in this order or even be used. Again, these are ONLY suggestions.

Suggestions Include:

- Highest Educational Standing
- Major/Minor in college or what you graduated with.
- Scholastic Achievements/Honors Leadership roles
- General Goal or Objective in competing as it relates to becoming Miss Minnesota or as it relates to Career Ambitions
- Activities/Accomplishments
- Include Your Unique Skill Sets: leadership, strong communications skills, effective speaker, exceptional organizational skills, fundraising, social media, bi-lingual etc.
- Interests: traveling, scrapbooking, yoga, white water rafting, etc.
- Any interesting facts that relate to your abilities to carry out the duties of Miss Minnesota.
- Be creative – sell yourself – be honest – don't embellish

For creative and colorful template ideas for your Resume, visit canva.com or crello.com and search RESUMES. Do NOT use card stock. Use of presentation paper is encouraged if resume is in color.

IN REVIEW:

Submit the document as a PDF and label it: TITLE, NAME, SOCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT.

For example, Elle Mark is Miss Minnesota, so her file would be labeled:
